I, Judge Sylvia Steiner, Single Judge responsible for carrying out the functions of Pre-Trial Chamber I in relation to the proceedings of the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and any cases emanating therefrom,

NOTING the “Decision authorizing the filing of observations on applications for participation in the proceedings” of 23 May 2007 (the “23 May 2007 Decision”), whereby the Single Judge ordered the Registry to provide the Prosecution and the Office of Public Counsel for the Defence with a copy of the victims’ applications for participation,¹

NOTING Regulation 23 bis (3) of the Regulations of the Court,

NOTING the information provided to the Single Judge by the Registry, according to which the Prosecution requested access to document ICC-01/04-325-conf-Exp + Anxs 1 to 30 through TRIM,

NOTING the information provided to the Single Judge by the Registry that, for the purpose of facilitating access to such document through TRIM, it is necessary for the Single Judge to reclassify the level of confidentiality of the annexes and that, as a matter of fact, the above referred document contains 40 (forty) annexes, and not 30 (thirty) as mentioned by the Prosecution,


CONSIDERING that the electronic copies of victims' applications for participation were already given to the Prosecution and the Office of Public Counsel for the Defence in accordance with the 23 May 2007 Decision,

CONSIDERING therefore that, at this stage of the proceedings, the proper reclassification on the confidentiality level of the forty annexes corresponding to the victims' applications is necessary and appropriate to facilitate access through TRIM by the Prosecution and the Office of Public Counsel for the Defence to such applications,

FOR THESE REASONS,

DECIDE to reclassify annexes 1 to 40 of document ICC-01/04-325-Conf-Exp as Confidential, Ex parte, Prosecution and Office of the Public Counsel for the Defence only
